FACTS	WHAT DOES THE WESTERN UNION FOUNDATION DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	This Privacy Statement describes how we collect, use and disclose your non-public personal information ("Information").
What?	<p>The Western Union Foundation ("We" or "Us"), and third party independent service providers on our behalf, collect Information about you from a variety of sources. The Western Union Foundation is not a financial institution; we are a separate charitable corporation that is tax-exempt under §501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, contributions to which are tax-deductible for US income tax purposes. The Foundation is supported by its donors and works to support education and disaster relief efforts as pathways toward a better future. You can learn more about the initiatives we support and our funding focus areas by visiting our website at https://foundation.westernunion.com.</p> <p>The types of Information we collect, use and share can include, without limitation:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • name, address, email address, mobile and home telephone number • donation amounts and history • credit card and payment information • any directions you provide to us about how your donation should be used <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • computer and mobile device information such as the domain and host you use to access the Internet; your computer's IP address; mobile device geolocation; mobile number and other information from and about your device (such as device properties, settings, applications, stored information and usage) and carrier; the browser and operating system software you use; social network handle and any other information from social media profiles you instruct social media providers to provide to us; the date and time you access our website and the Internet address used to link to our website when you visit us. <p>The Western Union Foundation may collect, store, or transfer Information via computers or other transfer or storage devices in the United States and elsewhere when you supply Information.</p>

<p>How does The Western Union Foundation protect your Information?</p>	<p>To help protect your Information from unauthorized access and use, we endeavor to use reasonable information security measures designed to comply with applicable law. These measures can include physical, technical and procedural safeguards, such as (but not limited to) secured files and buildings. We also endeavor to limit Information access to only employees, service providers and representatives that need to know. Despite our efforts, third parties may unlawfully intercept or access your transmissions to us or may wrongly instruct you to disclose information to them by posing as the Western Union Foundation or by misinforming you about our activities. Always use caution and good judgment when using Internet and mobile technologies.</p>
<p>How does The Western Union Foundation collect your Information?</p>	<p>1. We collect your Information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • make donations to or through us <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • submit information to us on grants, gifts or donation applications, or other forms and by other means • use or visit our website (for example, to make a donation) • interact with electronic communications we send to you

- interact with us via social media and instruct social media providers to provide information to us

2. Third party service providers may provide us with Information about you when they process donations on our behalf, or when they interact with you regarding your donation(s), beneficiary activities, or future events.

3. We may use Internet technologies like cookies and web beacons to collect Information for other purposes, including, but not limited to, those identified below:

- to assist us in providing services to you
- to allow you to change web pages during your visit without having to re-enter your password
- to store your preferences and other information and to track activity on our website
- to better understand the effectiveness of our activities
- to determine whether you came to our site from a banner ad or a third-party website
- to deliver information specific to your interests on additional web sites
- to determine whether you've acted on communications we have sent to you

Our website or related microsites may be linked to or from third party websites and/or social media platforms. If you visit such third-party websites and/or social media platforms, they may collect and use data about you subject to their own privacy notices. The

Western Union Foundation is not responsible for the content or privacy practices employed by websites and/or social media platforms that are linked to or from our website.

We do not honor any Web browser "do not track" signals or other mechanisms that provide you the ability to exercise choice regarding the collection of Information about your online activities over time and across third-party websites or online services. In addition, other parties may collect Information about your online activities over time and across different websites when you use our website or any of our services.

Our website is not directed at children under the age of 13. The Western Union Foundation does not knowingly collect or maintain information at our website from persons under the age of 13.
